Nearly a dozen local North Valley chefs are stepping up in the most delicious way possible to support the local Girl Scouts this cookie season—by taking part in the 6th Annual Girl Scout Cookie Dessert Challenge!

Through the program, each chef has been assigned one flavor of Girl Scout cookies to use as inspiration for a dessert.

HOW TO GET INVOLVED
Now through February 28, each chef's restaurant will feature their unique take on their assigned Girl Scout cookie on their menu, with a portion of proceeds benefiting local Girl Scouting.

Your mission, should you choose to accept it—go out and try them all!
"We also hope to inspire home cooks across Arizona to buy an extra box or two this Girl Scout cookie season to create their own desserts," said Michael Lawson of The Thumb, a six-year participant in the Challenge.

Girl Scout Cookies will be available all month long. As in recent years, the Girl Scouts will have all cookies on hand for immediate customer purchase.
"Given that more than half of Girl Scout alumnae in business fields credit the Girl Scout Cookie Program with developing skills they use today—including money management, goal setting, and public speaking—selling Girl Scout Cookies has helped millions of female entrepreneurs over the past 100 years spark their careers," said Tamara Woodbury, CEO of the Girl Scout Arizona Cactus Pine Council.

According to Woodbury, all of the net revenue from cookie sales—100 percent of it—stays within a Girl Scout council's local area to benefit girls. Councils depend on cookie earnings to run their programming, and girls decide how to invest their troop's portion of the earnings in impactful community projects and personal enrichment opportunities.

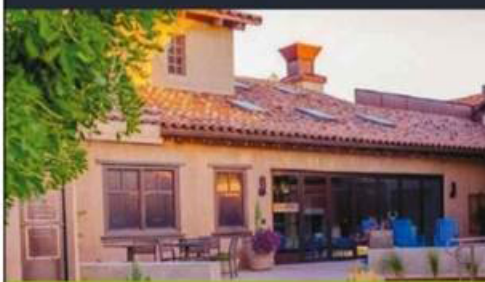
